## Principal's Corner

Titus 3

**3** Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and powers, to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work, **2** To speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, *but* gentle, shewing all meekness unto all men. **3** For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in omalice and envy, hateful, *and* hating one another. **4** But after that the kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man appeared, **5** Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by vthe washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; **6** Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour; **7** That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life. **8** *This is* a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly, that they which have believed in God might be careful to maintain good works. These things are good and profitable unto men. **9** But avoid foolish questions, and genealogies, and contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and vain. **10** A man that is an heretic after the first and second admonition nreject; **11** Knowing that he that is such is subverted, and sinneth, being condemned of himself.

**12** When I shall send Artemas unto thee, or Tychicus, be diligent to come unto me to Nicopolis: for I have determined there to winter. **13** Bring Zenas the lawyer and Apollos on their journey diligently, that nothing be wanting unto them. **14** And let ours also learn to maintain good works for necessary uses, that they be not unfruitful. **15** All that are with me salute thee. Greet them that love us in the faith. Grace *be* with you all. Amen.

We wanted to let you know that MySchoolWorx has an official app available for download on your Android or Apple smartphone! For those not familiar with smartphone apps, an app is a computer program or software application designed to run on a mobile device such as a phone, tablet, or watch. Apps are generally downloaded from application distribution platforms which are operated by the owner of the mobile operating system, such as the App Store (iOS) or Google Play Store. The MySchoolWorx app is free and connects administrators, teachers, parents, and students through messaging, alerts, and our school's calendar.

From this app, you can quickly compose new messages and reply to incoming messages, check your custom alerts and view assignments, events, announcements, and school holidays all from your mobile device. We hope you check out this wonderful app!

### Messaging

- create & send new messages
- read, reply to, archive and delete messages
- mark messages read/unread
- have access to the five folders already in MSW (Inbox, Draft, Sent, Trash, Archive)

### Alerts

- read & delete alerts
- mark alerts read/unread
- reply to message alerts

### Calendar

- view events, announcements, holidays, and assignments
- filter to view only one of the calendar event types (example: view only Holidays or view only Assignments, etc.)
