- 1. If you are a parent or guardian, you are a leader. If you confess Jesus Christ with your mouth, then the requirement for you is to be sound in your teachings to be sure you are teaching your kids the truth about the Word of God.
- 2. What you teach has a whole lot more to do with your works and what your works profess than it does with who you say you are. Young people learn more by watching than being told. If you were to get the chance to watch who you are in a mirror for an entire day, what would you learn from yourself? That is what you are teaching your kids.
- 3. If our culture seems to be overrun by quarrelling or foolishness and we are tired of these things, we cannot blame it on our government or our society. We must first look at ourselves, because it starts in the home.

So to sum this message up: parents or guardians, you are the greatest of leaders and change begins with you and me. What we are teaching our kids is not what we confess with our mouths, but what we do in our daily lives. The conversations with our kids only hold validity if they see us holding to what we are saying.

For those not familiar with smartphone apps, an app is a computer program or software application designed to run on a mobile device such as a phone, tablet, or watch. Apps are generally downloaded from application distribution platforms which are operated by the owner of the mobile operating system, such as the App Store (iOS) or Google Play Store. The MySchoolWorx app is free and connects administrators, teachers, parents, and students through messaging, alerts, and our school's calendar.

From this app, you can quickly compose new messages and reply to incoming messages, check your custom alerts and view assignments, events, announcements, and school holidays all from your mobile device. We hope you check out this wonderful app!

Messaging

- create & send new messages
- read, reply to, archive and delete messages
- mark messages read/unread
- have access to the five folders already in MSW (Inbox, Draft, Sent, Trash, Archive)

Alerts

- read & delete alerts
- mark alerts read/unread
- reply to message alerts

Calendar

- view events, announcements, holidays, and assignments
- filter to view only one of the calendar event types (example: view only Holidays or view only Assignments, etc.)
